

A Workaround for Instagram Viewing and Posting on Your Desktop

I want to share **an Instagram work around** that we figured out recently that I'm excited about (maybe you guys already know about it).

Instagram being mobile has always been an issue for my library **because you have to use mobile devices to post** and we aren't allowed to use our personal devices so sometimes it's a hassle

But we figured out a **way to view it online and post!** For some this works in regular browser, but **only works for me if I'm in incognito mode.**

- **In Chrome**, go to your Instagram page.
- Go to the top right next to the url bar where the three vertical dots are, click on that and then:
- Go to *More tools – developer tools*.

This looks scary but stay with me.

- At the top of developer tools, second in from the right is *this toggle device icon*.
- Click on that and refresh your window where Instagram is and voila!
- It should show you the mobile version **and let you post.**

Maybe this is old news, but I was excited so wanted to share!
